Job Title: Nursery Manager

**Job Type:** Part-Time, approximately 32 hours per week.

#### **Duties:**

- Propagating and growing native plants: starting plants from seed and cuttings, dividing and repotting, managing disease.
- Determining plant species and quantities to grow using sources like BONAP's Taxonomic Data Center and the USDA PLANTS Database.
- Managing and working alongside nursery technicians.
- Nursery maintenance: planting, weeding, and pruning. Maintaining growing supplies and ordering new inventory like soil, tree tubes, and other equipment.
- Implementation of Integrated Pest Management (IPM) practices. Safe handling and responsible application of herbicides when necessary.
- Keeping up-to-date plant inventory using spreadsheets and computer software like Square.
- Pulling plant orders for customers, design installations, and plant sales.
- Communicating with the team on plant inventory for use in designs and marketing for sales.
- Taking photos and videos for use on the website and social media and communicating with the team.
- Ability to be a good teammate and flexibility to work in an ever-changing environment with demonstrated ability to prioritize and juggle competing tasks.
- Using gardening equipment like trowels, soil knives, shovels, and wheelbarrows.

- Lifting 50 lbs bags of soil or mulch.
- Occasional garden installation/maintenance work: weeding, planting, watering.
- Occasionally assist with plant sales and events.
- Other duties as assigned.

#### Qualifications:

- Plant identification, botany knowledge, and prior growing/nursery experience.
- Must be passionate about the natural world.
- Able to perform physical labor in an outdoor environment. We work in all types of weather conditions, including heat, rain, and extreme cold.
- A willingness to learn and follow directions.
